if I make my bed in Sheol, you are there.

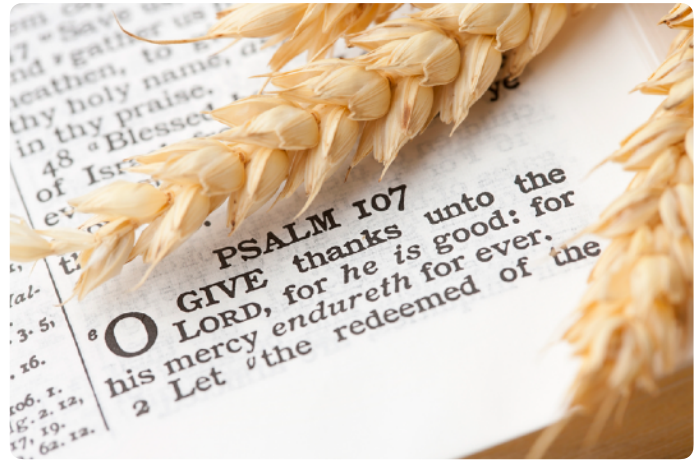
8. If I take the wings of the morning
